

CREATE A FORT WILKINS MOBILE

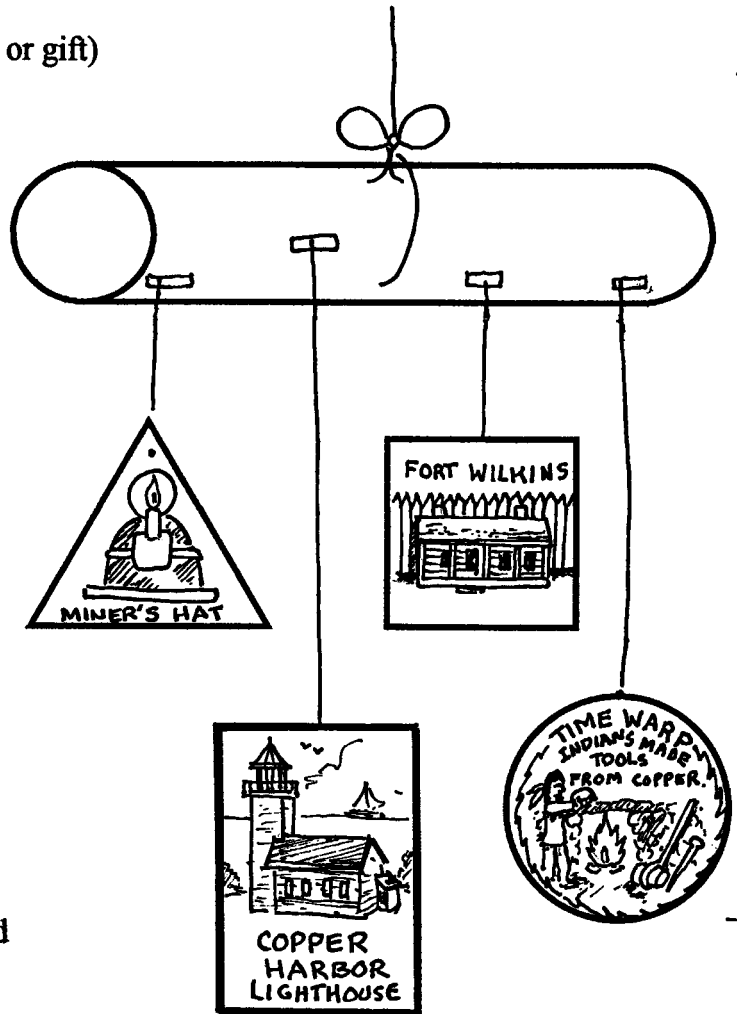
Create a mobile to show what you have learned about Fort Wilkins.

MATERIALS:

- ✓ construction paper shapes (squares, rectangles, circles, triangles)
- ✓ white drawing paper
- ✓ yarn
- ✓ cardboard tube (from paper towel or gift)
- ✓ scissors
- ✓ crayons or markers

DIRECTIONS:

1. On the white drawing paper draw pictures of important things you learned about Fort Wilkins. Color your pictures.
2. Mount each one on a construction-paper shape.
3. Punch a hole at the top of each shape.
4. Tie a piece of yarn to each one.
5. Make four slits in the cardboard as illustrated.
6. Force the yarn through the slit and secure it in place with a knot.
7. Hang your mobile by another length of yarn tied at the center.



NOTE: This can be used for any of the parks we have studied.
