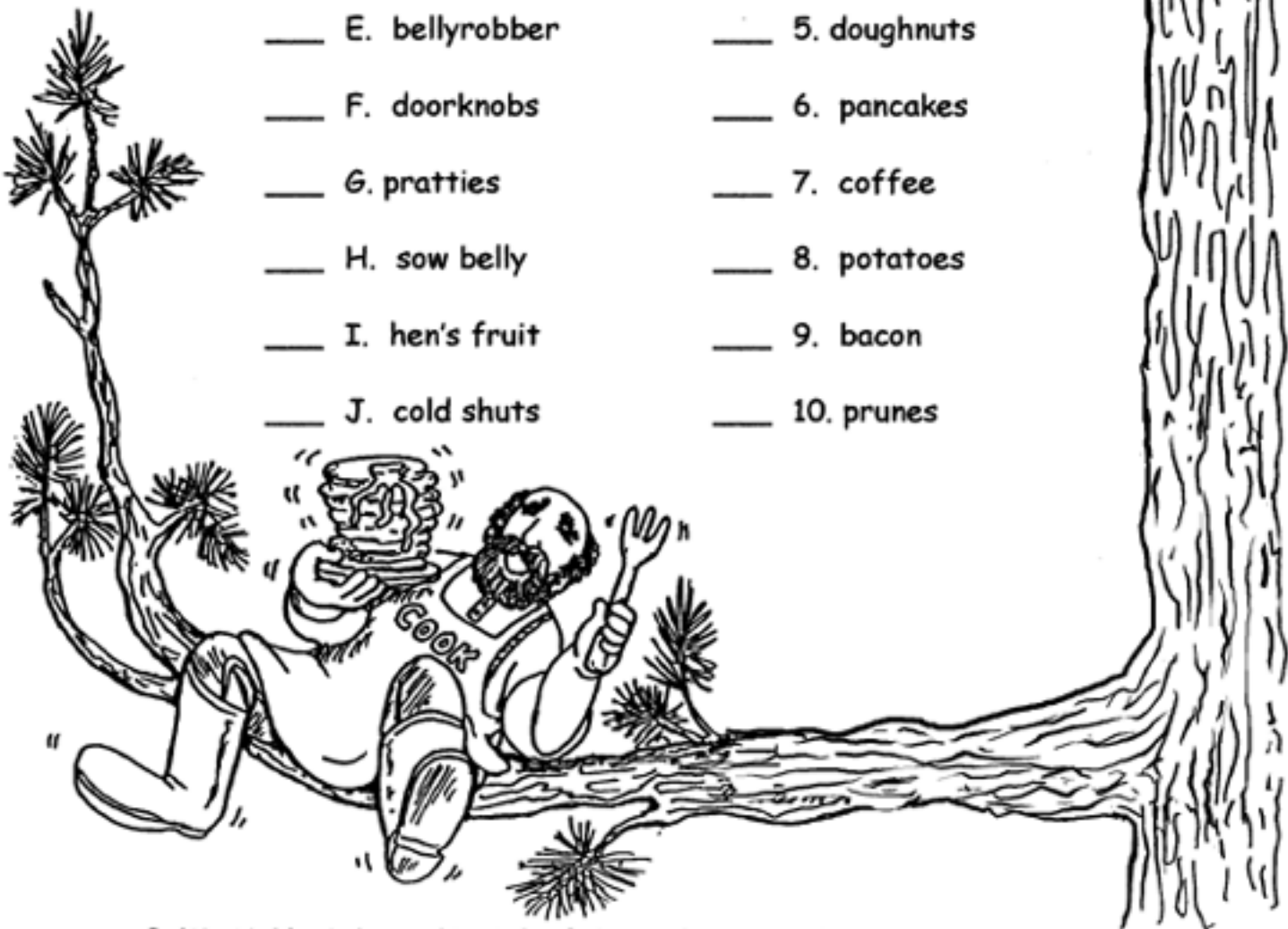




## LUMBERJACK LINGO
