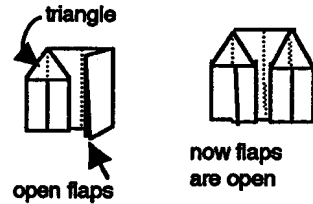
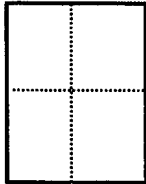


ORIGAMI FARM HOUSE AND BARN

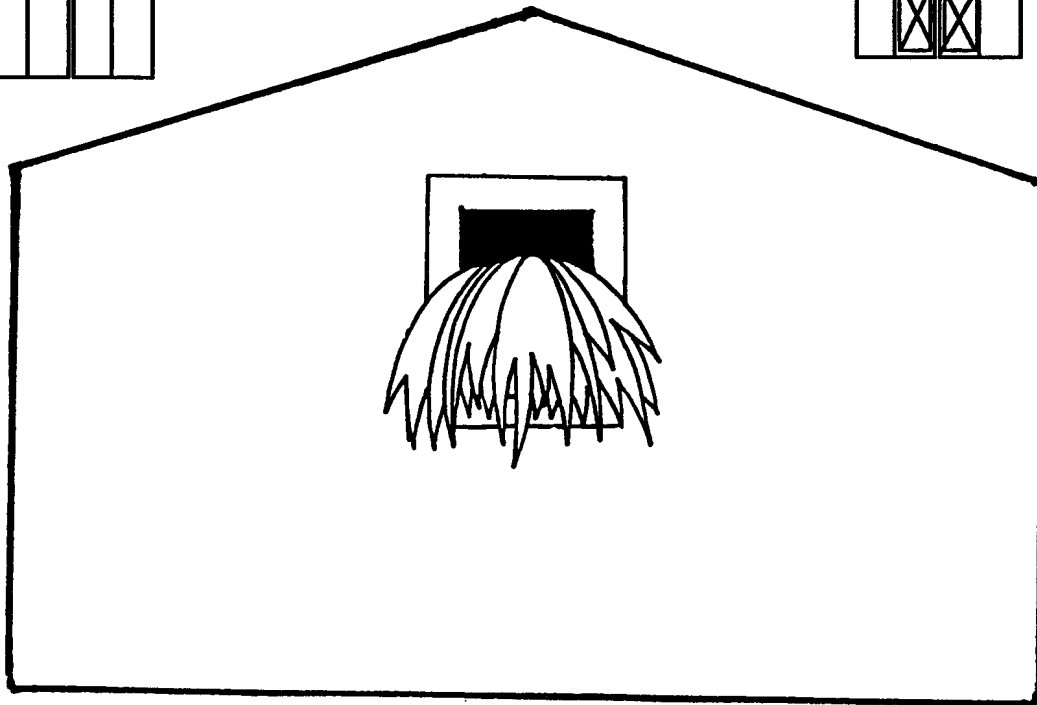
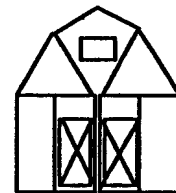
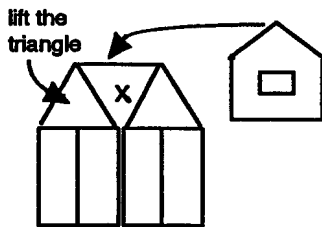
Follow steps one through three to make an origami farm house.
 Follow steps one through five to make an origami barn.

1. Fold 12 x 18 construction paper into fourths. You may wish to use red for the barn.
2. Open to the first fold and fold the ends in to meet at the middle.
3. Open the outside flaps and push down on the triangle to form the roof and doors.



4. Color the barn's hayloft to match the barn. Glue it onto the barn at the space marked X by lifting the triangles. (The hay loft covers the space marked x.)

5. Where the flaps meet in the middle, draw barn doors or glue the doors found on ORIGAMI FARM HOUSE AND BARN, PAGE TWO.

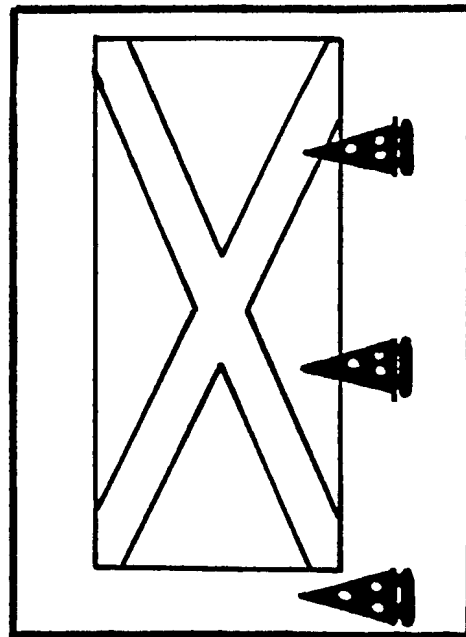
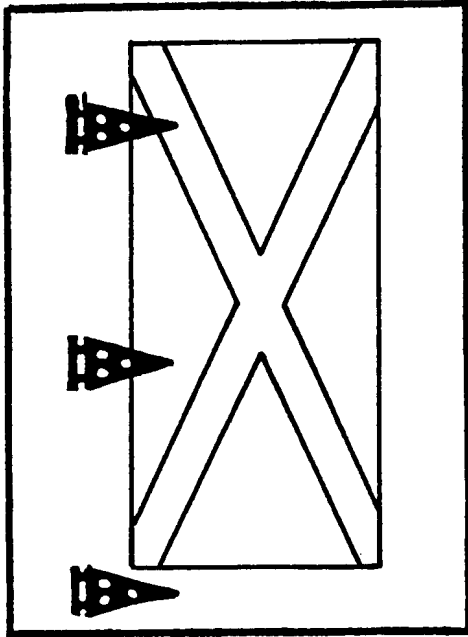

Remember to write complete sentences and use correct punctuation.
