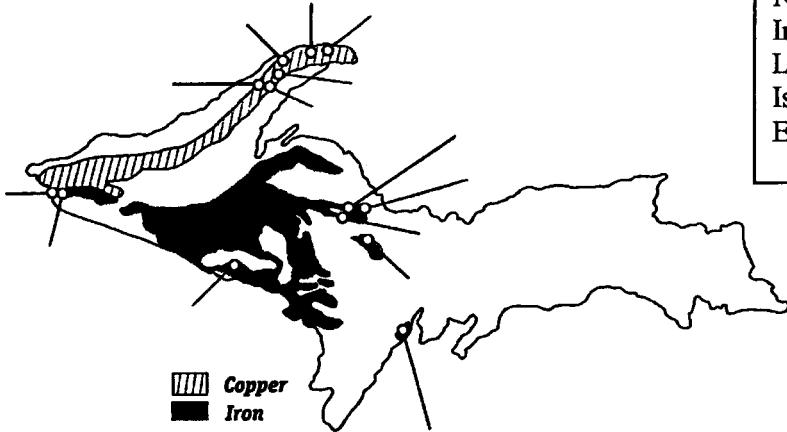


MICHIGAN'S MINING TOWNS
