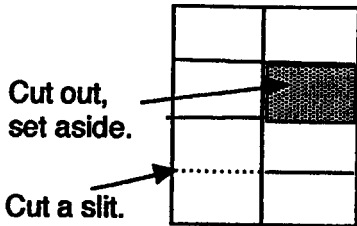


# STORY TENT PAGE 1

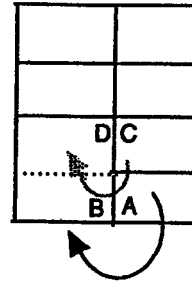

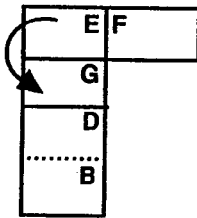
2. Cut out the title page and set it aside. Cut a slit on the dotted line.



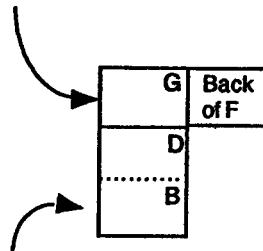
3. Fold sections A and C behind sections B and D.



4. Fold section E down behind section G.

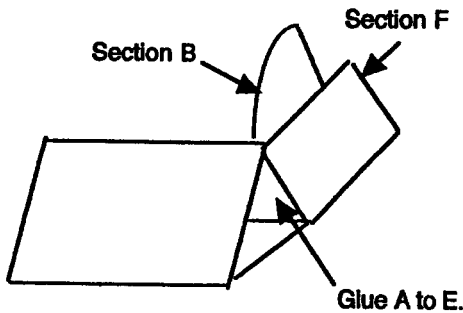


5. Section E is behind G.

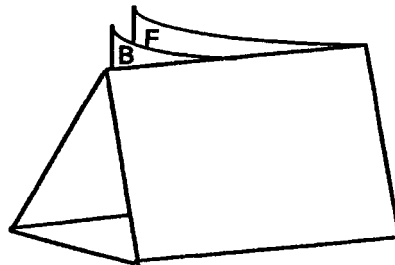


Section A is behind B.

6. Fold section A backward to meet section E. Glue section A to E to form a tent.



7. Section B is over section A. Fold section F over section B to form book pages. Glue the title page from step two to the back of section F for the book cover.



8. Use the book pages to write a camping story. Include who, what, where, when, why and how.

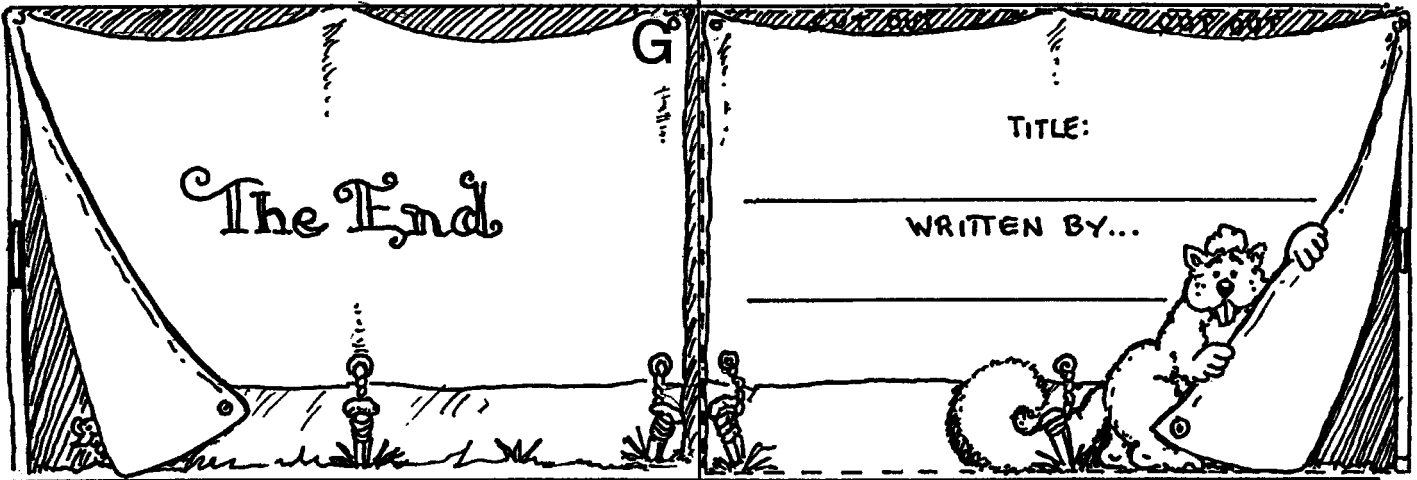
9. Make your own scenery for the tent or use the activity called SETTING UP CAMP.
