

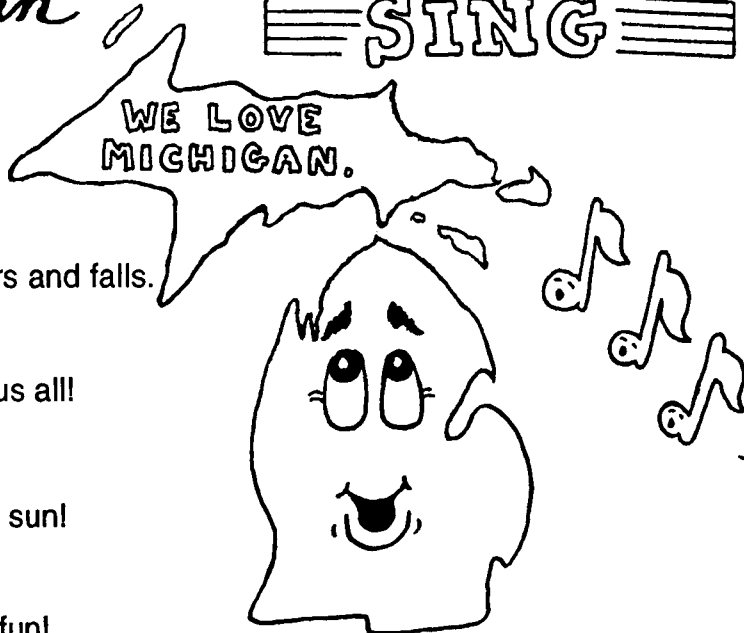
# We Love Michigan
